Lawful fireworks may be discharged in the city between the hours of 9 a.m. and 11:00 p.m. on the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd, 9 a.m. to 12:00 midnight on the 4th, and between 9 a.m. and 11:00 p.m. on the 5th of July. No fireworks are allowed to be discharged on any city property including the pool parking lot, park or the arena. Fireworks are to be shot off on private property only. The fine for violating this ordinance is \$25 minimum, \$200 maximum. Have fun but follow the rules. Thank you!

If you have not yet registered your animals and given proof of rabies, tags are \$20.00 each the first week of July. Please get your animals registered, March 1st was the deadline to avoid a \$1.00 per week increase. This has been in the newsletter many times.
